



ECONOMIC FEE PAYING INTAKE FOR THE 2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Kamuzu University of Health Sciences (KUHeS) is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates for admission into its full time economic fee paying degree programmes for the 2022/2023 academic year that starts in February 2023.

1. Minimum Entry Requirements

The eligible applicants are as follows:

- a) Candidates who completed the MSCE, IGCSE or O Level equivalent in the past three years (2019, 2020 and 2021);
- b) Candidates with an Advanced Subsidiary (AS) certificate or a National Senior Certificate (NSC) obtained in the past three years (2019, 2020 and 2021);
- c) Candidates who completed the Advanced (A) Level, International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or A Level equivalent in the past three years (2019, 2020 and 2021).
