Please note that the Malawi Medical Journal (MMJ) will publish a special issue for 2023 Research Dissemination Conference abstracts. All abstracts will be peer-reviewed and successful investigators will be informed by Wednesday, 1st November 2023. The closing date for registration and payment is Tuesday, 14th November 2023.

Applicants will be required to pay registration fees as follows;

- **Undergraduate students:** 1. MK25,000
- 2. Postgraduate students: MK30,000
- **KUHeS faculty members and** 3. affiliates staff: MK45,000
- 4. Other local delegates: MK75,000
- 5. International delegates: \$150

Limited conference grants will be offered to students that submit high quality abstracts. Students will be required to fill appropriate conference grant application forms online.
