A. MASTER OF MEDICINE (MMED) IN THE FOLLOWING SPECIALIZATION: INTERNAL MEDICINE; EMERGENCY MEDICINE; OBSTETRICS AND GYNAECOLOGY; PEDIATRICS & CHILD HEALTH; PSYCHIATRY; SURGERY; TRAUMA AND ORTHOPAEDICS; FAMILY MEDICINE; ANAESTHESIA; EAR, NOSE AND THROAT (ENT) (March 2024 in take)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or its equivalent from any recognized university.
- Proof of registration and a letter of good standing with the Medical Council of Malawi as a Medical Practitioner
- One-year post-internship clinical work experience.

B. MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH (MPH) (March 2024 in take)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in a relevant subject (e.g. medicine, nursing, social sciences, psychology, environmental health) from any recognized university
- A minimum two years of work experience in a relevant field postgraduation is required.
- Research experience or scientific publications are desirable
- Candidates interested in health informatics should have experience in information technology and indicate this area of interest on the application form.

C. MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN HEALTH SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT (MBA-HSM) (March 2024 in take)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

 A Bachelor's degree in relevant disciplines (or equivalent qualifications approved by the University) e.g. health systems management, business administration, medicine, nursing, biology, physics, mathematics, statistics, environmental health or:

• A Postgraduate Diploma or a Postgraduate Certificate of Business Administration in Health Systems Management or its equivalent qualifications (approved by the University) attained not less than a year preceding the application and a BSc or BA in a relevant discipline.

D. MASTER OF SCIENCE IN EPIDEMIOLOGY (March 2024 in take)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A Bachelor degree (or equivalent qualifications) in a relevant science subject (e.g. medicine, nursing, biology, physics, mathematics, statistics, social sciences, psychology, environmental health) from any recognized university or

G. MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ANTIMICROBIAL STEWARDSHIP (March 2024 in take) ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- At least a credit/second class Bachelor's degree in a relevant subject from any recognized university.
- A minimum of two years of work experience in a relevant field is essential
- Prior Research experience or scientific publications is desirable

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

MBBS, MBChB, BDS, Bachelor of Nursing and Midwifery, Bachelor of Science in Physiotherapy, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Science in Medical Laboratory Science, or similar equivalent health professional qualification for an accredited university

The program will be run on multiple exit strategy, and candidates may exit with Postgraduate Certificate, Postgraduate Diploma or a Masters in Health Profession Education.

Applicants must Currently be involved in teaching, assessing or supporting the education of learners or colleagues. Students are responsible for ensuring they have adequate internet to access the online programme

Additionally, the students should hold a Ministry of Health ART provider certification or equivalent and be registered by the Medical or Nurses and Midwives Councils of Malawi.

PROGRAM (March 2024 in take)

These are postgraduate degree programs by research (2 years for MPhil; 3-4 years for PhD). Candidates may apply to be considered for (a) the Kamuzu University of Health Sciences PhD degree program or (b) the Joint KUHeS-University of Liver-pool PhD degree programs.

Applicants are strongly advised to have preliminary discussions with the relevant Heads of academic departments at KUHeS or Project Directors to enable matching the prospective student to supervisors or research groups and to develop research concepts before applying. Applicants without approved research concepts and supervisors will not be shortlisted. Candidates applying for these PhDs should contact the respective heads of departments in the School.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Masters' degree in a relevant subject from any recognized university or;

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A Master's degree in any field related to Mental Health from a recognized academic institution.

All applications should include;

- A one-page concept note of the proposed research
- completed postgraduate application form. (Available on line at KUHeS website)

The successful applicant will:

- Work within the AMARI-II offices under the department of psychiatry/Mental Health at KUHeS
- Be supported with tuition fees and a modest monthly stipend.

Z. MASTER OF MEDICINE IN PUBLIC HEALTH - MMED PUBLIC HEALTH (March 2024 intake)

This is a full-time programme delivered on a modular basis. The first part takes two years (year 1 and 2) and covers content of the Master of Public Health (MPH) program excluding the dissertation. The second part (year 3 and 4) focuses on practicals and will largely be taken in accredited training posts in various locations including public health institutes, district hospitals, zonal, central hospital, NGO and academic institutions. Students will rotate in different sections to ensure that they gain all the core competencies in public health. Completion of part 1 is a prerequisite for part two of the programme.

At the completion of a dissertation and terminal examination assesses the competences of the candidate and those who pass receive the Degree of Master of Medicine (MMED) Public Health and become eligible for specialist public health appointments. At the same time a portfolio of work is presented identifying the way the competencies have been reached.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or equivalent
- Registration with Medical Council of Malawi or relevant professional bodies; entry into part 1

OR

- Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or equivalent and an MPH or equivalent or Public health postgraduate diploma or equivalent and
- Registration with Medical Council of Malawi as a medical practitioner; entry into part 2.

 - Two reference letters (one academic and one professional)
- 3. Pay and upload a deposit slip of a non-refundable application fee of **MK15,000.00** for Malawians and **\$30.00** for non-Malawians.
