BACKGROUND

The Kamuzu University of Health Sciences (KUHeS) was founded by the KUHeS Act No. 20 of 2019, through a merger of Kamuzu College of Nursing (est. 1979) and the College of Medicine (est. 1991). The University's mandate is to meet the professional needs of society at the national, regional, and international levels by conducting research, providing consulting services, and imparting knowledge and producing transferable skills through teaching and learning, research, innovation and application. The University specialises in providing undergraduate and graduate training for health professionals, including nurses, midwives, physicians, pharmacists, rehabilitation specialists, nutritionists, and biomedical scientists/lab technologists.

KUHeS MACE DESIGN COMPETITION

KUHeS is proud to announce an exciting opportunity for creative individuals to contribute to the rich heritage of our institution by designing the official university mace. The mace, a symbol of authority and academic tradition, will be carried at all ceremonial events, including graduations and inaugurations, representing the values and history of our university.

Design Guidelines

Submissions should

- Reflect the University's Identity: The design should embody the Vision, Mission and Core Values of the Kamuzu University of Health Sciences.
- Incorporate Symbolism: Elements that represent the academic excellence, and cultural significance should be prominently featured.
- Consider Functionality: The mace must be practical for use in ceremonial events, with a design that is both durable and easy to carry.
- Material Suggestions: While you are free to suggest materials, the final product will likely include traditional elements such as wood and metal.

Submission Requirements

Submissions should include the following:

- Design Concept: A detailed explanation of your design, including the symbolism and materials used.
- Visual Representation: High-quality sketches, digital renderings, or 3D models of the proposed design from multiple angles.
- Dimensions: Proposed dimensions of the mace, ensuring it is suitable for ceremonial use (typically between 90cm and 1.3 metres in length).
- Personal Information: Your name and contact details.
 Submission Process
- How to Submit: Please send your design and accompanying documents to mace@kuhes.ac.mw with the subject line "KUHeS University Mace Design Submission - [Your Name]."
- Deadline: All entries must be submitted by 28th November 2024. Kindly be informed that late submissions will not be accepted. Judging Criteria

Submissions will be evaluated based on:

- Creativity and originality
- Symbolic relevance to the university
- Aesthetic appeal
- · Feasibility of production

All submissions shall be reviewed by a panel of judges who shall submit recommendations to the KUHeS Management and then the KUHeS Council for their approval.

Awards and Recognition

The winning design will be produced as the official university mace. The designer will be recognized at a special ceremony and featured in university publications. A monetary prize of **MWK1,000,000** will also be awarded to the winning entry.
